Whereas: The office of the Licking County Dog Warden would like to give an abatement on the penalty for dog licenses, allowing Licking County dog owners who forgot to license their dog(s) for 2024 to purchase a license and not pay the penalty; and,





That we do hereby approve/authorize the Licking County Dog Warden and the Licking County Auditor to forgive the penalty for residents who failed to register their dog(s) during the week of August 4<sup>th</sup> through August 10<sup>th</sup>. 2024. The additional penalty fee will not be enforced, and residents will only pay the \$22.00 regular license fee.


